Student Scholarship

The Las Vegas Chapter of the American Concrete Institute is dedicated to advancing education, technical practice, scientific investigation, and research into concrete materials and construction practices by organizing the efforts of its members as a non-profit service organization. As LVACI has grown as an organization, so has its commitment to encouraging students to pursue careers in concrete related fields and to enhance the level of professionalism and industry engagement of those students. To achieve this goal, the LVACI will award up to four \$2,000 scholarships for 2025, at the Board's discretion, based on student participation.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Up to four \$2,000 scholarships may be awarded to engineering, construction management, geological and material sciences students. In addition to the cash scholarship prize, the Las Vegas Chapter ACI will provide complimentary registrations for all LVACI continuing education events for one year to the scholarship winners.

SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA

- 1) Student must be currently enrolled in a post-secondary Nevada school (Community College or University).
- 2) Student must be pursuing an education in technical/professional fields associated with the construction/engineering industry.
- 3) Student must have an interest in concrete materials and/or concrete construction.
- 4) The scholarship recipients are expected to attend at least two LVACI technical presentation in 2027.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

- 1) Applications may be completed on or downloaded from the LVACI website www.acilasvegas.org.
- 2) Completed applications and forms must be submitted by December 31, 2025.
- 3) Scholarships will be awarded to selected recipients by January 12, 2026.

EVALUATION

Applicants will be evaluated on:

- 1) Involvement in concrete related activities.
- 2) Involvement in professional student organizations and extra-curricular activities.
- 3) Work experience - both concrete and non-concrete related (such as internships and research in concrete related fields.)
- 4) Written essay

The LVACI Scholarship Committee will review applications from qualified students and rank the students based on their proven interest in advancing design and construction that incorporates concrete.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- 1) **Work Experience/Internships** - Attach a word document listing your work experience or internships. Include company name, company address, job title, and your employment dates. Briefly describe your job responsibilities.
- 2) **Professional activities/memberships/extracurricular activities** - Attach a word document listing any professional activities, memberships, or extracurricular activities you have been involved in while enrolled in your current program. Include the organization name, with dates and a brief description of your involvement.
- 3) **Signed application form.**
- 4) **Transcript** - Please include an official copy of your most current college or university transcript to document your course work.
- 5) **Essay** - Attach a word document (minimum 500 words) on the following topics:
 - What are your career goals and ambitions within the concrete industry?
 - How do you intend to advance the use of concrete as a construction medium?
 - What experiences have you had in your academic and/or professional development to lead you and prepare you for those goals?

Your interest in concrete as a building material and your understanding of the profession should be reflected in the essay. Grammar matters. Creativity counts. (Be original and avoid rephrasing Google search results about concrete. We already know that concrete has been around since the Ancient Romans.) **PLAGIARISM WON'T BE TOLERATED!**
